DONATE YOUR USED EYEGASSES AND HEARING AIDS

During the month of October, Lions across the globe observe "Sight Conservation Month." In recognition of "Sight Conservation Month," the Whitehall Community Lions Club will emphasize the collection of used eye glasses. The used eye glasses that you donate are recycled to improve the vision for individuals in developing countries. Check those drawers and boxes at home and bring any used eyeglasses to the next Chamber meeting on October 6th.

Lions clubs throughout the world have been recycling eyeglasses for more than 80 years. The donated eyeglasses are sent to one of thirteen Lions Eyeglass Recycling Centers where Lions volunteer their time and services to prepare the eyeglasses for distribution by cleaning and categorizing each pair by prescription. Optical missions sponsored by Lions clubs and other groups distribute donated eyeglasses to needy people. Currently, it costs less than eight cents to provide someone with recycled eyeglasses.
